Every family's journey is unique, and personalized support makes all the difference. Our designated space is more than just an office, it's a welcoming environment where families connect, find guidance, and receive the support they need to overcome challenges and build a better life.

Our dedicated team walks alongside families to provide individualized coaching to help them set and achieve their selfdefined goals. In 2024, we provided 1,026 coaching sessions and ongoing support to 379 individuals. Coaches do more than problem-solve. They empower families to take control of their futures, offering guidance that leads to self-sufficiency.

Through resource navigation, we connect families to critical resources like housing, childcare, food, transportation, and healthcare, helping remove barriers that block the path to success. JPP's two-generation approach ensures both parents and children have the wraparound support they need, because strong families create thriving communities.

Innovation is at the heart of our work. We don't just offer services, we build relationships, create solutions, and walk with families on their path toward success. Every step forward is a step toward a brighter future, and we are honored to be part of those stories.



Ambrosia, a Navy veteran, a loving wife, and the proud mother of two, had aspirations to create a better life for her family. But like many families, she wasn't sure where to start or how to ask for help.

With help from her coach, Zoe, Ambrosia received handson guidance to tackle each of her goals: pay off debt, go back to school, and improve her mental health. Zoe supported her every step of the way, from enrolling in college to starting therapy.

In 2024, Ambrosia graduated from JPP debt-free, working toward her bachelor's degree, and is prioritizing her mental health through therapy. The guidance and care Ambrosia received didn't just change her life—it lifted her whole family.

We believe education is the key to breaking the cycle of poverty and creating opportunities. From early childhood through adulthood, we support families on their educational journey because learning never stops.

Parents who complete a college degree double their income. A parent's level of educational attainment is also a strong predictor of a child's success. That's why we support parents who want to go back to school, earn their GED, or continue their education. We assist with tuition, enrollment, financial aid, and tutoring, making education feel possible and not out of reach. For children, we provide the tools and encouragement they need to stay on track in school, graduate on time, and dream big about their futures.

64% of participants achieved their education goals.

Every diploma earned, every college acceptance received, and every new career started is a victory, not just for one person, but for an entire family. Education is not just about school, it's about hope, confidence, and a brighter future. At JPP, we stand beside our families every step of the way, from a child's first day of preschool to a parent walking across the stage to receive their degree.





Yareli, one of JPP's hard-working high school students, dreams of becoming a neurosurgeon.

She is committed to academic excellence, including honors in both French and Spanish, and someday making a meaningful impact in the medical field.

In 2024, Yareli had the opportunity to attend the prestigious Medicine and Health Care High School Summer Program at Duke University, part of the National Student Leadership Conference (NSLC). There, she gained hands-on medical experience, developed surgical skills, and earned college credit, bringing her one step closer to her goal.

Yareli is one of many JPP youth who pursue their dreams with passion and perseverance, supported by a community that embraces their entire family. Her journey toward becoming a neurosurgeon inspires and highlights the potential for greatness within every individual, regardless of background or circumstances.

A stable job is more than just a paycheck - it's the foundation for a thriving family and a strong community. JPP empowers individuals by building confidence, developing skills, and connecting them to meaningful employment pathways that improve earning potential and career advancement.

Coaches focus on individuals' strengths to create goals to gain the skills, training, and education they need to feel confident entering the workforce. Ongoing coaching helps to remove barriers from career journeys to promote job retention.

By investing in career development, JPP helps people find jobs, strengthens the local workforce, drives economic growth, and creates opportunities for families to achieve lasting financial stability. The ripple effect of this work means that children of parents with stable, well-paying jobs are more likely to achieve higher incomes themselves, perpetuating a cycle of prosperity.

69% of participants achieved their employment goals.

Patience, a determined and resilient mom, took bold steps toward a meaningful career to create a better life for her family. With the support of our amazing partners at CrossPurpose, she gained the confidence and skills needed to pursue a career in Bookkeeping.

Through workshops and hands-on learning, she developed the expertise to excel in her field and secured a bookkeeping job. Patience also received CrossPurpose's prestigious All-In Award, recognizing her dedication and commitment to personal and professional development.

Patience now has a job she's proud of, doing work she loves, and is on the path toward economic freedom. Her journey is a powerful reminder that with the right support, a steady job becomes more than a paycheck; it becomes a path to purpose, pride, and possibility.

True stability starts with well-being. That's why we take a holistic approach to health, ensuring families have access to the comprehensive support and services they need to thrive.

JPP helps families navigate the healthcare system, empowering them to make informed choices about providers and advocate for their needs. We do more than connect families to services—we remove barriers and address the underlying challenges that contribute to health disparities.

We provide access to comprehensive mental health services, preventive care, and wellness programs, equipping families with the tools to manage life's challenges and build resilience. By emphasizing preventative care, we help families manage chronic conditions, improve overall well-being, and reduce healthcare costs, leading to a healthier, more stable future.

67% of participants achieved their mental health goals.

When families feel supported in mind, body, and spirit, they are better equipped to pursue their goals, care for their children, and build a strong future. At JPP, we don't just focus on success - we focus on sustainable well-being that lasts for generations.

Sunny's path to success was anything but easy. After her family lost everything in a fire, she faced the daunting task of rebuilding her life. At the time, she was caring for a child with significant needs and a husband battling a severe, undiagnosed health condition, which left him unable to work. Sunny, once a full-time mom, was now the primary earner for her family.

She found a lifeline in Head Start, which gave her children a safe place to learn, and she was introduced to JPP. **Through sheer determination and positivity, Sunny pushed forward and graduated from Red Rocks Community College and secured a teaching job.** The most life-changing support came when Sunny's JPP coach helped her navigate the healthcare system, leading to her husband's epilepsy diagnosis and stabilizing her son's health. **With the right care, her husband returned to work, and her son is now walking, talking, and meeting developmental milestones.**

Today, Sunny is no longer reliant on public assistance, her family is thriving, and has even started a college fund for her children, ensuring they have opportunities she used to think were out of reach.

Neurofeedback sessions.

In 2024, we introduced onsite Neurofeedback services—an innovative, no-cost resource that helps families improve emotional well-being by regulating emotions, reducing stress and improving focus.

MOBILITY Prestring Pathways to Star

In Jefferson County, a family of four must earn \$100,084 annually to meet basic needs without assistance, while the federal poverty line for that family is only \$32,150. This

staggering gap leaves many hardworking families struggling to get by, even while doing everything right. Every family that joins JPP is living below the poverty line. Yet, they come to us with hope, resilience, and a strong determination to create a better future for themselves and their children.

Financial literacy is a key pillar of economic mobility. A study by the Aspen Institute found that a \$3,000 increase in a parent's income when their child is young is associated with a 17% increase in the child's future earnings. JPP equips families with the skills to build credit, reduce debt, and grow their savings through workshops and personalized coaching. These foundational skills open the door to life-changing opportunities, like purchasing a home, buying a reliable car, or paying for college.

In just three years, **families increase their annual income by an average of \$34,000**, transforming their financial outlook and paving the way for generational success.

Having a stable home is more than a roof overhead; it's the foundation for families to flourish. When families have a safe, consistent place to live, they can focus on their goals: pursuing education, advancing in careers, and raising children in a place filled with love and hope. That's why JPP offers immediate support like rental assistance to prevent eviction and homelessness, while also walking alongside families on the path to homeownership. This year, three families broke through the barriers of generational poverty to become first-time homeowners.

Maria's journey is a powerful story of resilience. Maria was a single mom at 17, working minimum wage jobs. She joined JPP with a clear vision: pay off debt, continue her education, and start a childcare business. With support from her coach, she took accounting classes, increased her income, and gained the confidence to reach her goals. Today, Maria is a proud homeowner and successful business owner, proving that with determination and support, anything is possible.

COMMUNITY Building Stronger Jam

Community connection is at the heart of everything we do, creating a sense of belonging, support, and shared purpose.

When families feel connected, they feel empowered. At JPP, we are more than a program; we are a community where families find strength in one another and build a future filled with hope, resilience, and opportunity.

In 2024, JPP hosted 22 community events that brought families together for learning and connection. Every event strengthens family bonds and creates special memories, from financial literacy and parenting workshops to our Annual Gingerbread Contest and Achievement Ceremony.

These gatherings offer resources while providing a place for families to share their dreams, celebrate achievements, and support one another on their journeys toward self-sufficiency.

Four-Week Small Group Series

JPP offers two four-week workshop series each year focused on essential life skills, including financial literacy, mental health, stress management, parenting, and career exploration. These sessions provide families with valuable knowledge and practical tools to enhance their well-being, stability, and future success.

Volunteers from the **Lighthouse Therapy Team** and dedicated interns played a vital role in leading our 2024 small group workshops, offering expert guidance and personalized support. The **Jefferson County Public Library** provided engaging activities for children during these sessions so parents could participate fully while their children enjoyed fun and enriching experiences.



Searching & Shopping

JPP's Annual Searching & Shopping event celebrates empowerment and opportunity through a career readiness program. This event provides JPP participants with a supportive space to practice interviews, refine resumes, and access professional clothing so they can step into job opportunities with confidence and dignity.

Thanks to the generosity and unwavering support of **Storyline Church and its volunteers**, Searching & Shopping remains a cornerstone event for JPP job seekers, proving that when a community comes together, lives change, confidence grows, and futures improve.

They also inspire other families with their resilience and enrich the JPP community with their stories of growth and transformation.

As we celebrated inspiring accomplishments and the people behind them, we heard encouraging personal stories from Congresswoman Brittany Pettersen and Jeffco Public Schools Chief of Family and Community Partnerships Tara Peña. Volunteers and support from Jefferson County Head Start also helped make the event a success.





Back-to-School Bash

Every August, our Back-to-School Bash ensures families have the tools and knowledge they need for a successful school year. Parents receive guidance on supporting their children's education, and thanks to our partnership with **The Action**Center, JPP children receive backpacks filled with school supplies to start the school year off strong.

Authority, and Habitat for Humanity, JPP supports families
with transitional housing and pathways to affordable, stable
homes. Our main goal is to prevent homelessness before it
happens. In times of crisis, we also collaborate with partners like
White Swan Motel to provide emergency support.
